## **Definition of Engagement Opportunities**

- **Guest Speaker** Company representative visits school/classroom and present and answer questions about careers and/or business and industry.
- Career Mentoring Company representative meets one-on-one or in small group of student(s) to share insights and provide guidance about the workplace, career opportunities, and education/training requirements.
- **Job Shadowing** Company hosts student(s) for job shadowing experiences during which student(s) observes the workday of an employee, interacts with clients/ customers, and attends meetings and other appointments.
- **Workplace Tour** Company hosts students for in-person tours to meet employees, ask questions, and observe work in progress.
- Career Fairs and Expos Company provides representative(s) to attend career fairs and expos at schools or other events to showcase company and its opportunities.
- **Informational Interviews** Student conducts formal interview with company representative to learn about industry, profession, and/or education and career paths.
- Real-World Scenarios Company provides real-world concepts to help students apply their classroom lessons/units.
- Workplace Challenges Company provides problem-solving exercise for students (under supervision of teacher) to analyze, address, and/or make recommendations about.
- Curriculum Resources Company provides consumables and/or financial support for the purchase of relevant materials to complete hands-on classroom lesson or demonstration.
- **Summer Help** Company hires individuals for summertime help.
- Part-Time Help Company hires individuals on a part-time basis.
